- The area around the station is very convenient with assorted shops, hospitals, and other establishments.



HIGHER INSTITUTES

Currently, you pay money to study. However, you will be earning money within a few years. So we aim to pass on "self-sufficient Japanese" to our students. We consider preparation for entrance exams for higher educational institutes (graduate schools, undergraduate universities and colleges, vocational schools) as a part of the Japanese language education.

We will do our best to make our students pass the entrance exams for higher institutes through our courses.

GRADUATE SCHOOL

- To delve into the academic field you have pursued at undergraduate
- 2 years for MA/MS, 3 years for PhD

EXAMINATION QUALIFICATION

- You must have formally graduated from a college in your home country.
- The field of research must be related to academic field of your under graduate study.
- You must have enough Japanese skills to read and understand technical books.
- You must be able to make contact with a professor to work with and write a dissertation.

UNIVERSITY

- The first 2 years for general education and preparation courses for major subjects.
- The latter 2 years for major subjects.
- Start of a job hunting from December of the third year.

EXAMINATION QUALIFICATION

- The EJU score is necessary. Make sure to take EJU.
- Which university you can apply largely depends on the score of EJU.
- Some faculties require the skills of math or English.

VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

- Graduation in two years.
- There are a lot of schools specializing in variety of fields such as automotive, IT system engineering. tourism, cuisine, and finance, so you can find your field of interest for sure
- Some vocational schools are tran sferable to universities.

EXAMINATION QUALIFICATION

- Attendance rate of Japanese language school must be more than 85%.
- Japanese Language Proficiency
 Test N3 and higher





HIGHER INSTITUTES PREPARATION **COURSE OVERVIEW**


Our school sets the enrollments dates 4 times a year; April, July, October and January. All courses set the graduation date in March.

Class hours are 4 hours a day, Monday to Friday, AM9:10~12:25 or PM 13:10~16:25. The class will be determined through the placement test.

ENTRANCE QUALIFICATION

- Students who have completed a school curriculum of over 12 years in a foreign country.
- Students who have a Japanese language skills equivalent to JLPT N5, J.TEST F class, NAT-TEST Class 4 or higher. A person who fulfils both of above conditions and graduated from the final academic institute less than 5 years ago.

Please submit the application form in person or by mail and then pay the screening fee via bank transfer or in person.

- 5. If you have had stayed in Japan for a long time or applied for granting a Certificate of Eligibility, be sure to mention it.



TUITION FEE

The tuition fee includes the cost of textbooks, printing, accident insurance for foreigners, and school events (extracurricular activities, overnight trips, etc.). However, the cost for the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students, Japanese Language Proficiency Test, and voluntary participation events must be payed by yourself.

Please pay the tuition fee for the first full year after receiving your student visa. (table 1)

From the second year, you can pay tuition fee for every six months. (table 2)

Tuition fee refund policy

- 1. We will refund the amount other than screening fee If the Certificate of Eligibility is not issued.
- 2. We will refund the amount other than screening fee and enrollment fee after the Certificate of Eligibility is issued if you ① do not apply for visa ② do not receive visa ③ canceled enrollment before coming to Japan even though visa was issued.
 - * We will refund after having confirmed the return of your Certificate of Eligibility and the admission letter. The transfer fee for refund must be paid by the applicant.
- 3. As a general rule, tuition fee will not be refunded after enrollment.
- 4. Handling fee for the bank transfer fee must be paid by a remitter.



DORMITORY FEE

The student dormitory is located close to the school within 15 minutes walk or by bicycle.
